Twice a year I hit the road and perform allergy awareness assemblies across North America with the goal to educate more people about this growing health condition.



About the "Let's Go Nuts" Tour

From mid-March until mid-November, I will be performing at schools as well as at public venues.

- 140 Days of performances
- Over 200 individual performances
- Approximately 30,000 people reached live
- Shows across Canada and the United States

At every show I provide a mix of music, puppets, games and stories while I educate about:

- Allergy/anaphylaxis
- Signs and symptoms
- Epinephrine
- Keeping friends with allergies safe
- Understanding and respecting each other's differences (anti-bullying)

About Food Allergies & Anaphylaxis*

- Food allergy is a growing public health concern in the U.S.
- More than 15 million Americans have a food allergy
 - o Approximately 9 million or 4% of adults, and 6 million or 8% of children
- Food allergies result in more than 300,000 ambulatory-care visits among children in the U.S. annually.
- Eight foods account for 90% of all food-allergic reactions in the U.S.: milk, eggs, peanuts, tree nuts, wheat, soy, fish, and shellfish
- Even trace amounts of a food allergen can cause a reaction
- There is no known cure for food allergy; strict avoidance of the food allergen is the only way to prevent
